I have no doubt that you'll take our beloved association to greater heights!


You were indeed a pillar of support during my tenure. I got the strength to strive more to serve these wonderful & beautiful ladies.


We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion.

The followings are the summary of the significant accounting policies adopted in the preparation of the accounts of the Club.

Basis of Accounting

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention. No adjustment is made in the accounts for the changes in price levels and inflation.

Reporting Currency

The financial statements are presented in Nigeria Currency (Naira) which is the Club's reporting Currency.

Subscriptions are recognized on cash basis that is, subscriptions are recognized as income when it is received by the association.
